Guidance for submission of videos for Virtual Mare Grading 2024.

In order to enable the judges to fairly assess your mare for grading it is important to submit clear video clips as per the guidance below. Each video should be a maximum of 90 seconds so that the file sizes are not to large.

The mare should be well presented and plaited as she would be for a show.

7 Marks are awarded out of 10 for the following:

Type, Conformation (body), Conformation (legs), Walk, Trot, Canter, Overall Impression.

1: Type and Conformation:

Video showing mare stood up and walk slowly with camera around the mare so judges can see the whole horse from side, then directly in front, then to other side, then the view from behind. Stop for a few seconds on each view.

2: Conformation of Limbs and feet:

Video showing a close up from the front of horse showing the front legs when stood up. Then walk around to back of horse to show hind legs from side and rear.

3. Correctness:

On a hard level surface, Video showing the mare walking directly away from the camera for at least 10 strides. Turn around and walk back to the camera. Repeat this in trot. Try to keep the mare moving in a straight line so the judges can clearly see the correctness of the movement.

Trakehners UK is the marketing name of the Trakehner Breeders' Fraternity. The TBF is the only UK body licensed by the Trakehner Verband to register, grade and brand pure-bred Trakehner horses for inclusion in the Main Trakehner Stud Book.

4. Paces

In an arena where the mare can be loose. Each with a separate short video Walk: Firstly walk in hand on left rein and then the right rein.

Trot: Show trot loose with good forward movement on both reins. Please try to show the best movement of the mare.

Canter: Show canter loose on both reins.

5: Overall Impression

Finally Show a good view of the mare, Stood up to show the conformation.

Please complete an entry form for each mare that you wish to submit for grading. The virtual grading entries close 20th September 2024.

The video submissions must be received by the TBF by the 20th October 2024.
